As the Executive Director you will need to develop partnerships with employers, developers and the public sector to expand the supply of quality, sustainable homes and neighborhoods that meet the needs of Bozeman's workforce.

The Executive Director will regularly update and refine the organization's strategic direction in conjunction with the Board of Directors, and will be responsible for fundraising, elevating the community's understanding of Headwater's mission, building relationships, and assuring the operational and financial soundness of a start-up organization.

### **Primary Responsibilities**

Leadership and Advocacy

- Represent the organization in the community to promote its mission and enhance its profile.
- Create partnerships with employers, developers and local government to expand Bozeman's supply of below-market homes.
- Build Headwaters' relationships with local, state and regional housing advocates.
- Advocate for policies and programs that promote affordable homeownership, sustainable homes and neighborhoods, and permanence of affordability.

Fundraising & Financial Management

- Develop an annual fundraising plan and direct its implementation.
- Serve as primary fundraiser for the organization with support from board and staff.
- Oversee all financial reporting activities of the organization.
- Prepare an annual budget, monitor monthly cash flow, and provide regular reports to the Board.

#### Organizational Development

- Work with the board to update, implement, and regularly assess a strategic plan to guide the
  organization.
- Foster an effective and collaborative relationship with board members, committees, and staff.
- Build and develop organizational capacity.
- Lead a positive work culture with clear roles, shared purpose and collaboration.

#### Operational Management

- Lead development of Headwaters' program goals, strategies, and messaging.
- Develop an annual organizational work plan.
- Manage staff and contractors.
- Track and report Work Plan results to board.
- Ensure the operations of the organization are carried out ethically in accordance with the organization's bylaws.
- Develop and implement human resources policies, procedures and practices.
